Following the conclusion of Jerry's presentation, a motion was made, seconded and approved for our Assembly to donate \$1,000. To the Memorial Parkway. This was the first reading.

A second reading was voted for a \$2,500. contribution to the Jacksonville Veterans Treatment Court.

The Meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.
